



# How Avance Will Help Marriages and Families

Family Bridges partners with local organizations to help them dynamically engage with their communities and develop leaders. We train facilitators how to teach social-emotional and professional growth curriculums, share our best-practices model for delivering memorable workshops, and offer marketing support for reaching those in the community.



What type of training is offered?

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• Leadership Training: Church leaders receive training on leadership skills such as time management, project management, goal setting, decision making, creative problem solving, discovering talent and the use of technological resources.


• Marriage and Family Educational Training: Church leaders receive training on parenting, marriage, and finances which they in turn pass on to other couples and families through educational workshops and activities.

• Engagement Training: Church leaders receive training on recruitment and retention of couples and families and make provisions for the continuation of the program through the succession of leadership after the 3 year Avance contract is over.











The ultimate goal of engagement is to build an emotional connection. It is a process that leads to intimacy and advocacy. It's not a single transaction, but an ongoing conversation and process. It's having a constant presence.

• Each participating church commits to forming an active local ministry for marriages and families.

• AVANCE Institute recruits 4-8 church leaders and trains them in developing the local parish AVANCE Institute.

• AVANCE provides the training for participant couples and children. The leaders are trained in maintaining an open approach by communicating ideas while listening to multiple perspectives from others. Support, fellow-ship, and accountability encourages participation and servant leadership in carrying out the mission, objectives, and activities of the program. The mutual respect fostered through the participation in the management of the program leads to an atmosphere of trust among leaders and participants.

• Partnerships with educational, private, and community organizations brings additional resources to enhance the program and as well as extend its outreach.

• As the ten church work together in this collaboration, they all grow stronger.

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What is required of a participating church?

• A commitment to host the program for three years

• Adequate space for ongoing educational family strengthening workshops and events

Promotion of events

• An open door for AVANCE Institute to recruit volunteers for leadership and participants
